THE COMPOSERS

EDWIN SANCHEZ (Playwright - Librettist) Playwright Edwin Sanchez's plays have been produced around the world as well as throughout the United States. His upcoming musical, I'll Take Romance will have its world premiere in Ohio later this year. His plays include Clean, Trafficking in Broken Hearts, Unmerciful Good Fortune and Diosa. Among his awards are the Kennedy Center Fund for New American Plays, three New York Foundation for the Arts Playwriting/Screenwriting Fellowships, the Princess Grace Playwriting Fellowship, the Daryl Roth Creative Spirit Award and the AT&T On Stage New Play Award. He is also the author of the novel, Diary of a Puerto Rican Demigod, which has been slated to be a podcast series in 2023. A resident of Connecticut he teaches playwriting at Wesleyan University.

MICHAEL LEAMON (Composer - Music & Lyrics) An Indianapolis native, Michael Leamon first composed as a teenager, accompanying revivals of silent films. He improvised his own scores for Butler University's silent film series and did it again after graduation. He first combined his passion for theater and music by interpolating his own material into local community theater, followed by dozens of shows in dinner theater and summer stock. He toured and did piano work for Yul Brynner's final run of The King and I. For Cincinnati Public Television he composed the music and directed a TV series of all 42 Dr. Seuss books, with politicians, news anchors, and Jerry Springer as his narrators. He played piano onstage in Cleveland for Playhouse Square's production of Forever Plaid, which ran 18 months. (Another Playhouse Square show, Forbidden Broadway, featured Abbey Theater's Joe Bishara.) Throughout, Leamon has been a constant, well-known performer at Cleveland's most upscale establishments.
